They found a surrogate community

They don't know what's at stake

"'Didn't you know I had to be in my Father's house?'" (Luke 2:49).

Why Should You Go to Church?

To identify as a follower of Christ

"What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside?" (1 Corinthians 5:12).

To be trained for victory

"I do not fight like a boxer beating the air. No, I strike a blow to my body and make it my slave so that after I have preached to others, I myself will not be disqualified for the prize" (1 Corinthians 9:26-27).

To stay encouraged in your faith

"let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds" (Hebrews 10:24).

To receive and share forgiveness

"Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you" (Colossians 3:13).
